



School Week Survey Results - Parent/Guardian


Grade Level Representation of Respondents




Do you believe that the current 4-day school week has had a positive impact, negative impact, or minimal impact on your student(s) overall school experience.




Do you believe that your student(s) have achieved academic success and growth with the current 4-day school week?




Do you believe that your student(s) attendance has improved as a result of the 4-day school week?
